


# ELKS ONLINE: FINDING THE LODGE ON FACEBOOK

Facebook is a free “social utility” that some Lodge members have started using to communicate about the Elks and post photos of Lodge events. It is well-suited for the Lodge because it has more privacy safeguards than similar services online.

If you would like to start using facebook, here are instructions about how to join and use it. Facebook works by adding “friends.” Once you have an account, you can become “friends” with Teddy, our mascot, who has his own account. You can also become a “fan” of the Lodge.


## SIGNING UP WITH FACEBOOK



After signing-up, you will receive an email to confirm your identity. Then you go back to site. When you log-on to facebook again, you can fill out as little or as much information about yourself as you want profile. Only people you confirm as “friends” can see your profile. There is no need to fill out personal contact information.



## ADDING TEDDY AS A “FRIEND”




